**SUPER SONGWRITER EVAN “KIDD” BOGART HONORED AT
58TH ANNUAL BMI POP AWARDS FOR BEYONCE’S “HALO”**

Son Of Late Music Legend Neil Bogart Continues Legacy

Los Angeles, CA (May 19, 2010) – Songwriting powerhouse, **Evan “Kidd” Bogart** was recognized for great national popularity as measured by broadcast performance last night for Beyonce’s “Halo” at the 58TH ANNUAL BMI POP AWARDS, honoring the writers and publishers of the most performed songs during the past year. “Halo” was recorded by American R&B singer Beyoncé Knowles for Knowles’ third studio album *I Am... Sasha Fierce* (2008). “Halo” won “Best Song” at the 2009 MTV Europe Music Awards, and “Best Female Pop Vocal Performance” at the 52nd Grammy Awards, and was also nominated for “Record of the Year”. Bogart received a BMI Pop Award for “SOS” performed by Rihanna (2007) and “Take You There” performed by Sean Kingston (2009).

Grammy Award-winning songwriter Evan “Kidd” Bogart is the son of the late music legend, Neil Bogart. Bogart began his career in the music industry at the age of 16 and has helped launch the careers of many successful acts. In March, Bravo announced HITMAKERS; a reality elimination competition series featuring undiscovered singer-songwriters to executive produced by Bogart and others. In the meanwhile, he has written for artists such as Adam Lambert, Ashley Tisdale, Brandy, Britney Spears, Hilary Duff, Jennifer Lopez, Jessica Simpson, Keyshia Cole, Leona Lewis and Pussycat Dolls.
